I am writing on behalf of the Barton Hills Neighborhood Association. After our general assembly meeting on April 25th and a special codenext presentation held exclusively by our Area Development Coordinator Peter Hess this past Saturday May 13th, the area residents believe that the small window provided of all of 6 to 7 weeks to review and digest all of written land development code in conjunction with the map released is not a fair or a sufficient amount of time to properly examine all items with the large scope involved.

With the many inconsistencies present on the map, as well as the fact infrastructure (roads, water, sewer) was not taken into account with the mass densification to occur in areas of our neighborhood, we feel this land development code is being rushed through without giving proper consideration to the overall scope of what is involved.

The Barton Hills neighborhood association is putting in a formal request that we would like the review date to be extended to September 1st. I will leave my contact info below if you would like to discuss this further
