ACTIONS ALLEGED TO BE A VIOLATION:

The No on J PAC ("PAC") failed to timely file a \$10,000 contribution from the Real Estate Council of Austin (RECA) during early voting. This hid from the public their largest and political controversial contributor for 6 days until early voting was almost over. This is a well known political trick.

On its 8-day report, the PAC first disclosed on October 30, 2018 its \$10,000 RECA contribution. The RECA contribution was reported made on October 22, 2018. The PAC was required to file an ATX-1 report listing the \$10,000 contribution on October 25, 2018, pursuant to 2-2-32, because it made a \$500 expenditure on October 23 to John Michael Cortez. If the PAC had followed the law, the RECA \$10,000 donation would have been disclosed 6 days earlier than it was.

The PAC actually filed an ATX-1 report on October 26, but failed to report the RECA contribution. RECA's contribution makes up about half of the PAC's funds, so it is difficult to believe this was an oversight. RECA is a politically controversial special interest, especially as relates to land development and related issues like Proposition J. By failing to disclose its contribution, the PAC hid its largest and politically controversial donor from the public for at least 6 days. During the time they weren't reporting (keeping their donor's money dark), they were making false allegations against Let Us Vote Austin PAC and "dark money".

The PAC's failure to timely report appears to be intentional since sophisticated political insiders are heavily involved in the PAC, such as Mark Yznaga (political consultant) and John Michael Cortez (political aide). The PAC may have finally reported the contribution on the 8-day report, because that report is governed by state law, which has some teeth and enforcement.
